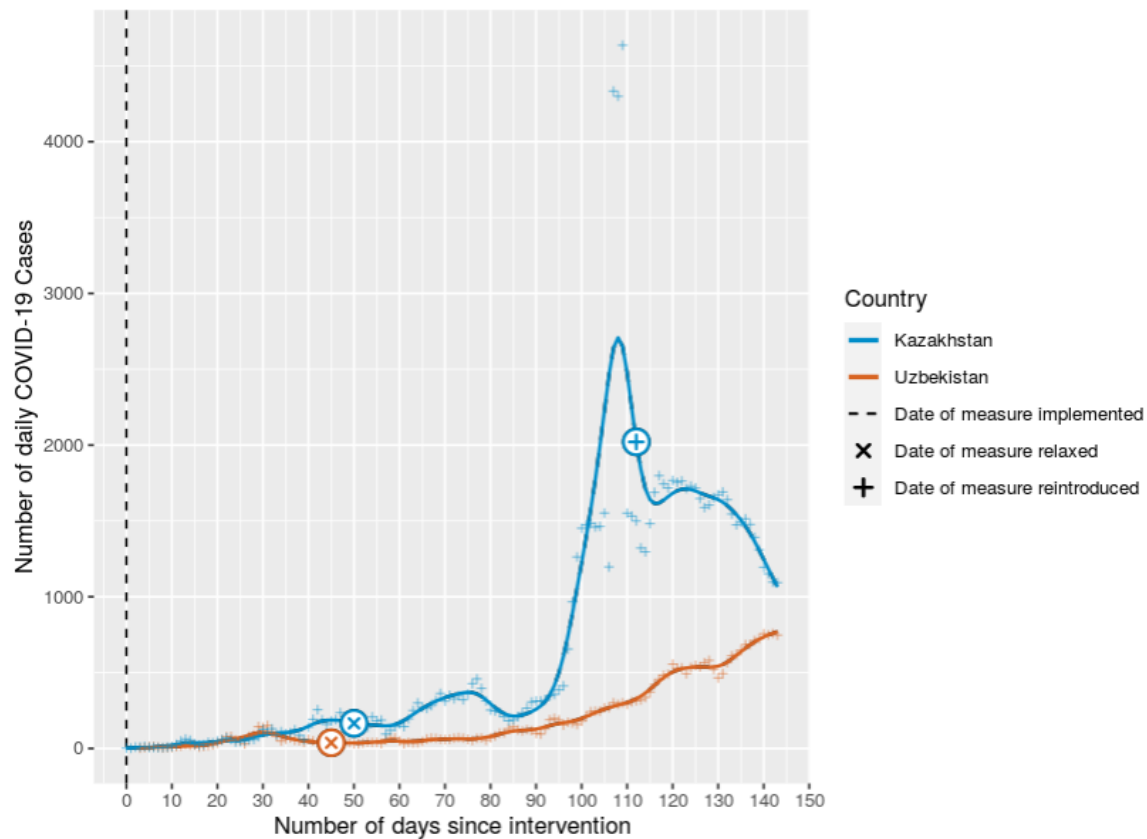

Ziel der Mission

The overall objective of the mission was to work with the national authorities on measures in place and planned in the context of the global COVID-19 pandemic and under the framework of the International Health Regulations.

- Exchange knowledge on the overall measures put in place to prepare for and respond to COVID-19;
- Review and support surveillance for COVID-19;
- Review the testing protocols and laboratory services put in place for the detection and confirmation of COVID-19 cases and the strategy for scaling-up laboratory capacities for COVID 19 testing;
- Review procedures for preparedness and response at PoE including contact tracing capacity, management, and organization of triage;
- Support hospital and health facility preparedness including infection prevention and control, and clinical management of cases.
- Discuss other challenges or technical questions related to COVID-19, as requested by Turkmenistan.
